

Free Generic Prescription Maintenance Medications and Diabetic Monitor/Testing Strips by Mail Through Rx 'n Go

To McKnight Place Employees on the Medical Benefit Plan:

You have the option to receive up to a 90-day supply of generic prescription maintenance drugs by mail **at no cost to you** through the Rx 'n Go prescription drug program. Nearly 1,200 generic drugs to treat on-going conditions are available **free to you** via Rx 'n Go! Only those generic drugs covered by your drug plan and on the Rx 'n Go covered drug list will be provided to you at no cost. In addition, you have the option of receiving up to a 90-day supply of **Prodigy**® diabetic test strips by mail at no cost to you. The initial test strip order includes a new **Prodigy**® diabetic monitor!

If you are <u>New</u> to Rx 'n Go, all that you have to do to get started is to complete your Pharmacy Profile Form (online at www.rxngo.com or by calling Rx 'n Go Customer Service at 888.697.9646) and then submit your prescription(s) to Rx 'n Go. The process for submitting your prescription(s) is easy and offers two options:

For Your Physician (after 7/1/15)

Have your physician / licensed health care practitioner E-Scribe, phone or fax your prescription(s) directly to Rx 'n Go:

- E-Scribe: use the name of our fulfillment pharmacy - Specialty Medical Drugstore
- **2. Phone:** 888.697.9646 (must come from your physician's office)
- **3. Fax:** 888.697.0646 (must come from your physician's office)
- Physician can fax (888.697.0646), email PDF copy to pharmacy@smdrugstore.com or mail a completed Pharmacy Profile Form directly to Rx 'n Go.

For You (after 7/1/15)

- 1. Complete the Pharmacy Profile Form
- **2.** Include the original prescription(s) from your physician/licensed health care practitioner
- 3. Mail the completed form and original prescription(s) to Rx 'n Go at the following address:

Note: Federal and state laws require the presence of the original written prescription for pharmacies to fill any controlled substance and narcotic medications. Mail original prescription to the address above for these types of medications.

Obtaining a New Prescription

If you are currently receiving any maintenance medication on the Rx 'n Go list through another pharmacy, you can contact Rx 'n Go customer service to get help obtaining a prescription. Rx 'n Go will contact your physician to obtain a new prescription for you. You will need to provide Rx 'n Go with the name and phone number of your physician along with the name and strength of the medication you are having transferred to Rx 'n Go.

Important! Only those nearly 1,200 generic drugs provided by Rx 'n Go will be paid at 100%. Any prescriptions received by Rx 'n Go for medications not on the Rx 'n Go covered drug list will be returned to you.
